Programme Objectives

The Hong Kong Budding Poets (English) Award (HKBPA) is a territory-wide writing competition for all primary and secondary school students in Hong Kong. It serves as a platform for students to express creatively through writing poetry in English. It aims to provide schools with a channel to identify gifted learners in English for extended training in creative writing.

The following services for the HKBPA 2021/22 are required:

- i. Training workshops for Primary level students and Secondary level students;
- ii. Adjudication;
- iii. Prize-giving ceremony; and
- iv. Compiling and editing the anthology.

Medium of Instruction: English

Training workshops for Primary level students and Secondary level students

Intended Learning Outcomes

Upon completion of training workshops, students should be able to:

- evaluate and identify unique characteristics of poetry genre;
- demonstrate mastery of the poetic devices of contemporary poetry, e.g. language, detail, voice, tone, literal and figurative imagery, rhythm, structure, theme, etc.;
- create their own pieces of poem with effective language use and enhanced poetry writing skills; and
- demonstrate enhanced enthusiasm in poetry understanding, appreciation and writing.



Target Participants: All participating students of the HKBPA 2021/22
Programme hours: 3 hours per each workshop, 18 contact hours in total
Period: December 2021 to February 2022;
Medium of Instruction: English with English handouts

Adjudication

Target: All entries submitted by participating students of the HKBPA 2021/22.
Period: March to April 2022
Medium of Instruction: English

Prize-giving Ceremony

Target: Awardees of the HKBPA 2021/22, parents, teachers, officiating and honourable guests. It is estimated to have 100 – 300 participants in total.
Period: Late May to early June 2022.
Medium of Instruction: English

Compiling and Editing the Anthology

Period: June to August 2022.
Medium of Instruction: English
