2020 International Junior Science Olympiad - Hong Kong Screening

Aims / Objectives

This Annex is to invite heads of secondary schools to nominate their students to take part in the 2020 International Junior Science Olympiad (IJSO) - Hong Kong Screening.

Details

2. The 2020 IJSO - Hong Kong Screening (Screening) aims at promoting science education in Hong Kong and providing an enhancement platform for students with high potential in science. The Screening is co-organised by the Education Bureau (EDB), the Hong Kong Academy for Gifted Education (HKAGE) and the Hong Kong Association for Science and Mathematics Education.

3. The Screening will be held in **late September 2019**. Details, including the date of competition, registration methods, background information and regulations of the competition, are available on the website of the HKAGE (<http://www.hkage.org.hk/en/competitions>). Schools wishing to nominate students for the Screening may refer to the details announced on the above website.



4. A series of enhancement programmes arranged by the HKAGE will be provided for the high-achieving students in the Screening. Those students with outstanding performance in the enhancement programmes would be invited to represent Hong Kong to take part in the 17th IJSO held in December 2020. The members of the Hong Kong team participating in the IJSO will be fully funded by the EDB.
