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Introduction

Children:

1. Discover and affirm one’s strengths to build self-confidence through preparing and performing a drama
2. Enhance expression and communication skills through interacting with gifted angels and other participants, and understand the importance of team spirit
3. Understand and develop one’s strengths
4. Learn in a fun environment and expand social circle

Gifted angels:

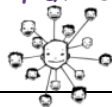
1. Learn the social skills for interacting with children and acquire the knowledge of drama through participating in prior workshops, and enhance teamwork skills through planning activities
