



Fee Remission Policy

The Hong Kong Academy for Gifted Education (the HKAGE) operates on an inclusiveness basis which means all student members, regardless of socio-economic backgrounds, learning difficulties or disabilities will not be placed in a position they are unable to participate.

Eligibility

Fees may be waived for academic programmes if the applicant is receiving the below eligible government subsidies:

Eligible Government Subsidy	Grant Rate (%)
Comprehensive Social Security Assistance	N/A
Financial Assistance Schemes for Primary & Secondary Students	Full grant (100%)

Fee Remission Guidance Notes

The applicants for fee remission should be the student and the parent / legal guardian of the student who is applying for academic programmes (e.g. overseas programmes) organised by the HKAGE. Please refer to the programme details. The decision of the HKAGE on all applications shall be final.

To apply for fee remission, please submit a completed **Application Form for Fee Remission / Increasing Overseas Programme Subsidy Limit** together with a copy of appropriate documentary evidence of the eligible subsidy to the HKAGE. Wherever appropriate, the HKAGE may approach the applicant for further information.

The applicant would receive a notification letter from the HKAGE for the results of Fee Remission application within one month from the date of application.

Please note that the fee of the applied programme would only be waived where its commencement date lies within the valid period of the eligible subsidy.
