As a reflective practitioner, Patrick Lam served as a school teacher and principal of primary and secondary schools for over 20 years, a member of various task forces in Curriculum Development Institute, Education Bureau and a project manager in Ministry of Education, New Zealand for external school review. He has been a guest lecturer at HKU, CUHK, HKIEd and OUHK as well as the speaker of over 200 workshops and seminars organised by primary and secondary schools in Hong Kong, China, Taiwan, Spain and Canada. He contributed over 30 articles to international journals, international conferences and their proceedings. He has been a learning experience designer and instructor of many stimulating gifted education programmes in various organisations for more than a decade, including being the Education Coordinator of Antarctica and Arctic expeditions in 2010 and 2011 respectively as well as the instructor of international collaboration projects in 2004-2010. Patrick Lam is currently the Associate Director of The Hong Kong Academy for Gifted Education. His main duties are to facilitate teacher professional development in gifted education and to strengthen relevant parent support.
