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Introduction to Speaker:

#### **Ms WONG Ying Kei, Vivian**

WONG Ying Kei, barrister-at-law, a 'twice-exceptional' alumni of the HKAGE LLB in Laws (LSE), MA in Psychology (CUHK), PCLL (City U)

People seeing my achievements may conveniently assume that my life must have always been bright, nevertheless. These are only half-truths. My journey with visual and mental impairments has in fact been a daily struggle, not to mention with my giftedness. Nevertheless, it is the 'labels' of giftedness as well as impairments that motivated me to prove everyone wrong.

'Perseverance' -This is the word that I lived by in the past years. It taught me 'labels' cannot define me. It is my courage to confront the 'labels' and accept the imperfect me to go beyond the boundaries; it is how I fought through my struggles and ran over the hurdles that ascribe my life a meaning.

Being a strong believer in diversity, equality and justice, I am keen on promoting these values in our community through advancing my personal experience, knowledge and understanding in special needs, drawing inspiration from my legal and psychology studies, and utilising the opportunities I have in my legal practice.
