Introduction

This group is an extension of "Parenting for a Peaceful World" parent workshop which aims at enhancing understanding of 10 connecting themes. It will also use reflective activities to help parents share mutual questions, thoughts, and opinions on connected themes (for example, connected children), so that parents can construct their own "language" in an interactive atmosphere.

This group aims at creating a learning community amongst parents of gifted children for mutual support. Parents are welcome to share their experiences and obtain feedback from others in an open-minded atmosphere. The group can also help parents develop positive solutions in a respectful environment.

Normally a 2-hour sharing session is held in each quarter. In the meeting, there is a presentation/sharing on a specific topic that stimulates parents' subsequent sharing and exchange.

1. To strengthen parent-child bonding by exploring social resources
2. To voice their concern(s) in a stress-free environment
3. To share, learn, and network amongst parents to support each other
4. To reinforce positive values and attitude of nurturing the gifted
5. To share information, ideas, and resources
