







“1+1” Group

<p>Introduction</p>	<p>Who says “1+1=2”?</p> <p>We dare to think, dare to act, dare to innovate, making “1+1>2” possible.</p> <p>“1+1” Group is a parent-child programme for primary gifted students and their parents. The programme design is based on the Creative Problem Solving (CPS) model (Isaken, Treffinger, Dorval, & Nollar, 2000), and infused affective elements such as parent-child communication, self-understanding, exploration of value systems and peer learning in an interactive learning environment. Through this programme parents and children can enhance their creative problem solving skills, make innovations and achieve breakthroughs. Children and their peers also have opportunities to communicate, collaborate and share their achievements through a range of activities. They will learn to appreciate each other and enhance their problem solving, collaboration, questioning, presentation, and multi-perspective thinking skills.</p>
