- Content** : This workshop welcomes all teachers and parents who are interested in Education for Sustainability (ESD) and hand-made art. In this handcraft workshop, the instructor will not only share the constructs about the Sustainable Development, but also instruct participants to handcraft daily products and art pieces by upcycling and reusing wasted materials. The instructor will also explore and share the experience of workshop and teaching designs. It aims at demonstrating the beauty and possibility to live with sustainability awareness and creative mindset.

Participants will get inspiration from the concepts and practices of turning trash into treasure via hands-on crafting in the manner of sustainability development. They will also learn how to teach students to explore novel ways of sustainability development with creativity, and to establish an novel value towards sustainability.

**Education for Sustainability (ESD)** is first introduced and discussed on the “Ten Years of the UNECE Strategy for Education for Sustainable Development”, a strategic plan to strengthen the understanding, the use, the value and attitude of Sustainability through education. It is a multidiscipline study for students to increase their **sustainability awareness**, build a sustainable and green **creativity mindset**, and practice their **21<sup>st</sup> Century Competencies**.

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- Objectives** : Upon completion of the workshop, the participants should be able to:
- identify the **trends of future education** in sustainability development with application;
  - make artistic art piece by upcycling;
  - integrate the concepts of upcycling and reduction of waste into daily teaching and living;
  - enhance the awareness of sustainability development so as to guide students to reflect upon environmental issues and self-value.
