



# From Tangible to Intangible

(HUMP1541)

## Introduction

This course allows students to explore both tangible and intangible cultures through field trips, looking into the impacts urbanisation has on Hong Kong's traditional culture. Participants will be able to apply different research methods to the investigation of selected topics. Meanwhile, by conducting role-play and projects, students will become more knowledgeable of the roles intangible culture play in the society and the difficulties of its conservation.

## Intended Learning Outcomes



Upon completion of the programme, participants should be able to:

1. Define the intangible cultural heritages from a global perspective;
2. Compare and classify the characteristics and cultural roots of intangible cultural heritage in Hong Kong;
3. Create products illustrating the importance of selected intangible cultural heritage and how it helps foster social cohesion and identity.

## This programme is Programmes with No Screening

There are no screening questions, written test or other screening methods for this type of programmes.

- Student members can select up to 5 programmes from a list of selection. Applicants have to state the priority when submitting the application. (1<sup>st</sup> priority, 2<sup>nd</sup> priority, 3<sup>rd</sup> priority, etc). 1 token is required for each programme (For programme list, please refer to page 42 to page 43 of [Gifted Gateway](#) Issue No.13;
- Application can only be submitted once. Once it is submitted, the priority and the programme selection cannot be changed;
- If a student member removes a programme from the application before the application deadline by withdrawal, the choice priority will remain unchanged. (For example: A student has selected three programmes and removed the programme with the 1<sup>st</sup> priority from the application. The choices of 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> priority will remain unchanged with no promotion in priority.);
- We will select the students based on the student's choice of priorities and a randomly generated selection by the computer system. If there is time clash between the applied programme and other programmes with offer, HKAGE will consider if the application will be accepted;
- Priority will be given to student members who have not completed the applied programmes;
- Student members should avoid applying programmes with time clash;
- The decision of HKAGE on the result of selection should be final.
