### Film Appreciation on "Wonder" (JC2W-PS021)

#### Introduction

We will screen the 113 minutes American comedy-drama "Wonder" (2017, written by Jack Thome, Steven Conrad and Stephen Chbosky based on the novel by P.J. Palacio), follow with 45 minutes open discussion and group activities on the "story of August Pullman, a boy with facial differences who enters the fifth grade, attending a mainstream elementary school for the first time." The unique story telling techniques applied in the film on magic realism and shifted narrative perspectives reveals the message we would like to deliver to gifted students and the parents - everyone has their own situations to handle with and everyone needs support in different ways.
