Introduction	<p>Humanitarian work opportunities can be found across the world. Aid workers are given chances to be close to the beneficiaries, involved within communities, giving hands-on support in areas such as education, healthcare and housing etc. Other tasks revolve around planning, administration and implementation of projects. Sometime aid workers may work in remote locations and face dangerous situation for emergency response of man-made or natural disasters. Being a humanitarian aid worker, you could experience very different difficulties found in Hong Kong offices but have a rewarding experience of having global perspective and simply thank you smiles from the beneficiaries. To be one of it, qualifications needed for this role vary. For some aid worker jobs, you may not need any qualifications. For some complicated and complex jobs, you'll often be expected to have career-specific qualifications. Let's find out what and how it takes to be one of humanitarian aid workers.</p>
