Introduction	<p>One may think scriptwriters are entirely independent, but in fact, they often need to communicate with different people to deliver their messages and make their ideas persuasive. Apart from good writing skills, scriptwriters have to be able to do in-depth observations to human behaviours and to get inspiration from daily living.</p> <p>In this introductory scriptwriting course, both parents and students will have chances to exchange thoughts, and we hope the participants will be more curious and passionate about life. Moreover, we encourage parents to be more supportive in students' personal growth, to walk and learn with them and to create some memorable summer experiences.</p>
