Introduction

One can follow his hobby in pursuing higher education and later turn that into career. The speaker Mr Savio Fong is founder and director of Galaxy Scientific Group, he is astronomy enthusiast since childhood and have decades long education and professional background in engineering, now established over 50 astronomy facilities in east Asia with clients from government, professional research institutes and universities in different countries. Mr Fong is also the first person to establish optical astronomical observatory at 5100m altitude in Tibet, with next plans in South America and Africa. In this talk, Mr Fong will share his thoughts and insights in STEM education, career development in science and engineering, re-industrialization of Hong Kong etc.
