

From Teacher to Teachers' Teacher (GSGW1010)

Introduction

There is an old saying in Chinese about the role of teachers: passing down the knowledge "Dao", imparting professional knowledge and resolving doubts (「韓愈《師說》：傳道、授業、解惑也」). However, in the 21st-century classroom, the role of teachers is shifted. Do you recognise your teachers are now playing other roles at school? They are not only the learning facilitator but also the party organizer, sports trainer, listeners, mentor, harmonious culture curator and so on.
