






# HSBC Future Skills Development Project: Financial Capacity - Savvy Planner Workshop (Primary) (APPP1001)

<p><b>Introduction</b></p>	<p>In this 2-hour activity-based workshop, participants will learn how to set financial goals, develop budgets, save money, make investment, and manage risks and debts through role playing as a youngster joining the workforce for the first time. The workshop will also help them review their self-management and planning capacities and enhance their financial knowledge and skills.</p> <p>During the workshop, participants will get hands-on experience achieving their short / medium-term and lifelong goals through proper time and financial management. The more goals one accomplishes, the higher is his/her planning capacity.</p>

<p><b>Intended Learning Outcomes</b></p>	 <p>Upon completion of the workshop, students should be able to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ Experience decision-making for life planning at different life stages;</li> <li>➤ Point out the significance of self-understanding in setting life goals;</li> <li>➤ Acquire the skills needed for setting personal goals in life and financial planning,</li> <li>➤ Review their own self-management and planning capacities.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Application Procedure</b></p>	 <p><b><u>This programme is Programmes with No Screening</u></b> There are no screening questions, written test or other screening methods for this type of programmes.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Student members can select up to 5 programmes from a list of selection.</li> </ul>

Applicants have to state the priority when submitting the application. (1<sup>st</sup> priority, 2<sup>nd</sup> priority, 3<sup>rd</sup> priority, etc). 1 token is required for each programme (For programme list, please refer to the issue 17 of Gifted Gateway ([click here](#)));

- Application can only be submitted once. Once it is submitted, the priority and the programme selection cannot be changed;
- If a student member removes a programme from the application before the application deadline by withdrawal, the choice priority will remain unchanged. (For example: A student has selected three programmes and removed the programme with the 1<sup>st</sup> priority from the application. The choices of 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> priority will remain unchanged with no promotion in priority.);
- We will select the students based on the student's choice of priorities and a randomly generated selection by the computer system. If there is time clash between the applied programme and other programmes with offer, HKAGE will consider if the application will be accepted;
- Priority will be given to student members who have not completed the applied programmes;
- Student members should avoid applying programmes with time clash;
- The decision of HKAGE on the result of selection should be final.
