

# How to be a "hybrid" of scientist and educator (GSGW1010)

**Introduction** Dr Patrick Yue is a current Faculty member of the Department of Biology, Hong Kong Baptist University (HKBU). He received his PhD at the School of Chinese medicine in HKBU and his scientific researches focus on the biomedical and pharmacological effects of herbal medicine and natural compounds and toxicology of environmental pollutants. Apart from his daily traditional knowledge delivery in classroom as a lecturer, Dr Yue also works to enhance student autonomy and motivate students to take ownership of their learning as he considers it very important and takes it as the most challenging task for every "educator". Applying experiences learnt while serving as the guest host and service provider in different public channels, Dr Yue has attempted to supplement the traditional lectures by incorporating blended learning or service learning in recent years. Through this attempt, a strong bonding between students and the community is fostered, and students become more aware of their social responsibility.
