

Source of Inspiration - Kwong Chun-yu Shares His Journey of Becoming a Writer

You are the one who is sentimental, full of inspiration, and enjoy writing. Have you ever dreamed of becoming a writer?

When you tell people about your dream, you may be ridiculed by someone else, 'Who will spend money on buying books now? Or even take the time to read it? How do writers make money?'

Dreams seem unrealistic and actually make sense. For our guest speaker, Kwong Chun-yu manage to turn his dream into reality, even if the road of creative writing is full of thorns, even receives the netizens ridiculed criticism, but he still insists to express his personal feelings via texts, introduce **Super Kwong's** views of love:

'Hurting oneself on the journey of love is not really bad, in fact, the most terrible thing is the loss of our simple self.' - Simple Girl

'Remember, if love has been expressed, it is just like the lid of the soft drink being opened. If you do not drink it in time, it will eventually lose its taste.' - Love Expressed Without Staying Together

'When I am alone, I really want someone to come and hug me, but being lonely for a long time, I found that I am the only one who can save myself.' - My Love Song

What are the secrets of success in the making of today's popular prose and fiction? Kwong Chun-yu will share with the students the relationship between inspiration, reflection, personal experience and the written works. He will describe the process of publishing books, explain the criteria for best-selling authors and their publications, as well as the development of the publishing and creative industry. The participants will learn how to become a writer and the tips for creating popular content.

Kwong Chun-yu, a member of the Legislative Council, a writer and a social worker. Mr Kwong began his career in romantic prose through facebook under the pen name 'Tree Cave', his page has attracted more than 170,000 likes. He won the bronze award for the most welcome author of the 2014 Hong Kong Golden Book Awards. He has written 'Love You Like the First Time We Met', 'There Is a Kind of Happiness Called Forgetting' and 'Reno Count to Three, and Together Let Go', all three works topped the best books list. Up till now, he has published more than ten books, his works showed genuine feeling.
