<p><b>Introduction</b></p>	<p>In this 2-hour activity-based workshop, participants will learn how to set financial goals, develop budgets, save money, make investment, and manage risks and debts through role playing as a youngster joining the workforce for the first time. The workshop will also help them review their self-management and planning capacities and enhance their financial knowledge and skills.</p> <p>During the workshop, participants will get hands-on experience achieving their short / medium-term and lifelong goals through proper time and financial management. The more goals one accomplishes, the higher is his/her planning capacity.</p> <p>Tutors of The HSBC Future Skills Development Project, sponsored by the HSBC and organised by the HKFYG, the HSBC Future Skills Development Project aims to provide education and training to re-skill young people, giving them the tools necessary for them to be creative, innovative and original. ## Application Procedure



### This programme is Programmes with No Screening

There are no screening questions, written test or other screening methods for this type of programmes.

- Student members can select up to 5 programmes from a list of selection. Applicants have to state the priority when submitting the application. (1<sup>st</sup> priority, 2<sup>nd</sup> priority, 3<sup>rd</sup> priority, etc). 1 token is required for each programme (For programme list, please refer to the issue 21 of Gifted Gateway ([click here](#)));
- Application can only be submitted once. Once it is submitted, the priority and the programme selection cannot be changed;
- If a student member removes a programme from the application before the application deadline by withdrawal, the choice priority will remain unchanged. (For example: A student has selected three programmes and removed the programme with the 1<sup>st</sup> priority from the application. The choices of 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> priority will remain unchanged with no promotion in priority.);
- We will select the students based on the student's choice of priorities and a randomly generated selection by the computer system. If there is time clash between the applied programme and other programmes with offer, HKAGE will consider if the application will be accepted;
- Priority will be given to student members who have not completed the applied programmes;
- Student members should avoid applying programmes with time clash;

The decision of HKAGE on the result of selection should be final.
