No matter in any disciplines, participants can contribute to conceive innovative ideas, targeting to resolve global challenges and to become proactive change makers in local as well as global communities. The ultimate goal is to equip students to become future leaders and participate in building a better world.



In 2015, world leaders agreed to 17 SDGs, also known as Global Goals, which aimed at achieving sustainable development in its three dimensions: economic, social and environmental, in a balanced and integrated manner. These goals have the power to create a better world by 2030, by ending poverty, fighting inequality and addressing the urgency of climate change.
