<p>Introduction</p>	<p>ASPIRATIONS is a series of talks and activities aiming at inspiring students to prepare and pursue their future studies, career and dreams.</p> <p>To many students, studying in Cambridge and Oxford seems like an unreachable dream. In fact, there are many opportunities for Hong Kong Students to enter the world-class Universities despite the higher school fees and strict academic entry requirements.</p> <p>In the talk hosted by Access Abroad Hong Kong (AAHK)*, a non-profit organisation founded by HKAGE alumni who are studying in Oxbridge. Student members at HKAGE will learn more about the scholarships available for studies at Oxbridge, and how to make a competitive application to these. They will also offer tips on personal branding, and introduce the free peer mentoring service provided by AAHK.
