



How to Make Money by Investment (E2ECO003C)

Introduction

This programme introduces some basic knowledge for understanding the nature and functions of different financial systems in Hong Kong through the study of different types of financial institutions and financial markets. It also enables students to appreciate the special features of the Hong Kong financial system in the context of an international environment.

Students are expected to acquire knowledge on elementary personal financial management; and to learn how business firms make investment decisions, raise and utilise finance capital and manage working capital. Students will also learn how to apply the concepts and theories of financial management, and practice strong analytical skills and critical thinking during the programme.
