Stanford University initiated the idea to voice out and normalize experiences of failure in 2009 and has developed the Stanford Resilience Project: "Stanford, I Screwed Up!". In one of the programmes under the project, students were invited to share their experiences about how they regain confidence after failure.

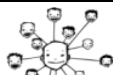
