Course Objectives

- : This Foundation Course aims to provide participants with the basic knowledge and skills in gifted education so that they would have a better understanding of the needs of gifted learners and to implement suitable learning provisions for them.

Course Description

- : The programme consists of a total of ten 3-hour modules. In each module, theoretical background will be introduced followed by hands-on activities. Participants are expected to participate actively through sharing their experiences in developing school-based gifted development activities. An extension assignment will also be required.

- Course Organiser** : The Hong Kong Academy for Gifted Education
- Target Participants** : Primary and Secondary Teachers new to Gifted Education
- Venue** : Rm E306, 3/F, East Block, Education Bureau, Kowloon Tong Education Services Centre, 19 Suffolk Road, Kowloon Tong
- Speaker and Facilitator** : Frontline practitioners on gifted education and officers of The Hong Kong Academy for Gifted Education and the Gifted Education Section, Education Bureau
- Certificate/CPD Hours** : A 'Certificate of Course Completion' will be awarded to participants who fulfill the following requirements:
 (i) completed eight modules out of the ten;
 (ii) submitted course assignments on time; and
 (iii) fulfilled the requirement of each assignment.
 The certificate is equivalent to that being awarded in Foundation Course: Educating the Gifted Students (36-hour Course).
 Participants who have completed each module will be given 3 CPD hours which is recognised by the HKAGE as one of the pre-requisites for higher level (intermediate / advanced) courses.
- [Note: This Foundation Course (in ten 3-hour modules), formerly organised by the EDB, will be re-run for the last time in July 09. Participants who cannot complete all the required modules in April 09 can continue to take the remaining modules in July 09 in order to be awarded the Certificate. The Hong Kong Academy for Gifted Education will continue to offer new foundation courses in the next school year. Details will be announced in our website.]***
- Medium of Instruction** : Cantonese
- Course Fee** : Free of charge
- Number of Nominees** : At most 2 from each school for each module
