1. ALL online applications should be nominated and approved by the school authority. Prior application is required and walk-ins will NOT be entertained.

This thematic learning event is designed primarily for frontline school practitioners and their cost is met from the public purse, we have decided that enrollment priority will be given to in-service principals, teachers and professional personnel (social workers and educational psychologists) in registered schools. However, we also welcome applications from pre-service teachers, educational psychologist trainees and social worker trainees when seats are available. Tertiary institution faculty, full-time undergraduates and postgraduates, as well as gifted education programme designers, coordinators, administrators of non-profit making organizations are also welcome to apply as a limited number of places will be reserved. However, personnel from non-registered schools and profit-making organisations are not eligible to join our programmes.
