- Students of aged 10-18 by the time of admission in Jun 2021 are eligible for applying for the Online Screening Programmes.
- There is no limit on the number of student applicants from each school. However, each student can only apply for the Online Screening Programme once either via school or self application during the primary school study and twice during the secondary school study. For each application, each student can apply for ONE Online Screening Programme only.
- Students who are under the age of 10 in Jun 2021 may also apply for the Online Screening Programmes. However, these under aged students who have passed the Online Screening Programme and nomination screening will receive tentative offers. Their HKAGE membership will only be activated in the following month after they have reached the age of 10. Besides, as each student can only apply for the Online Screening Programme once either via school or self application during the primary school study, so please consider carefully the above conditions to see whether it is the right timing for application.
- Existing HKAGE full or preliminary members shall not apply for the Online Screening Programmes.
