Introduction	<p>This online learning programme is an enrichment course focusing on mathematical knowledge. It aims to enhance students' knowledge and broaden their horizons in various areas of mathematics. This programme also provides self-learning elements in order to facilitate students' future learning in mathematics after completion of the programme.</p> <p>There are three modules and a final assessment in this programme:</p> <p>Module 1 - Number and Algebra Dimension Module 2 - Measures, Shape and Space Dimension Module 3 - Data Handling Dimension</p> <p>Final Assessment (You have to pass the Final Assessment in order to complete the online programme)</p>

Target Participants	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Students of aged 10-18 by the time of admission in Feb 2019 are eligible for applying for the Online Screening Programmes. ➤ Students who are under the age of 10 in Feb 2019 may also apply for the Online Screening Programmes. However, these under aged students who have passed the Online Screening Programme and nomination screening will receive tentative offers. Their HKAGE membership will only be activated in the following month after they have reached the age of 10. ➤ There is no limit on the number of student applicants from each school. However, each student can only apply for the Online Screening Programme once during the primary school study and twice during the secondary school study. For each application, each student can apply for ONE Online Screening Programme only. ➤ Existing HKAGE full or preliminary members shall not apply for the Online Screening Programmes.

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Remarks

- Students cannot change or withdraw from the Online Screening Programme they have applied after the application deadline.
- Students who have applied for the Online Screening Programmes via their schools cannot apply for any Online Screening Programmes via self application. Only the school application will be considered. School Coordinators please notify the students for this arrangement before submitting an application.
- If students apply via self application, their schools will be informed throughout the process including:
 - (1) Application for Online Screening Programme ;
 - (2) Online Screening Programme results;
 - (3) Submission of profile for self nomination; and
 - (4) Nomination results
- The quizzes/questions within the module are for your self-assessment of the learning progress.
- Only the final assessment contributes to your performance in this online programme.
- The time limit of the final assessment is 60 minutes.
- **You have to pass the final assessment in order to complete the online programme.**
- **You can attempt the final assessment 2 times at most within 3 Jul to 11 Sep 2018.**
Only the highest score will be counted.
- Questions may be different between two attempts.
