

Important Notice

1. Only students of the age of 10-18 by the time of admission in June 2022 are eligible for applying for the HKAGE “Online Screening Programme”. If students are under the age of 10 by the time of admission in June 2022, their HKAGE membership will only be activated in the following month after they have reached the age of 10.
2. Originally, each student can only apply for the HKAGE Online Learning Programmes for Screening once either via school or self-nomination during primary school study and twice during secondary school study. **This restriction will be lifted from the 2021/22 school year** and each school can nominate up to 50 students per year via school nomination. For each nomination, each student can apply for ONE “Online Screening Programme” only with a maximum of two attempts on the final programme assessment.
3. Students who have successfully passed all screenings will become HKAGE student members only by the end of the school year in June where Secondary 6 (or equivalent to the last year in secondary school) students will be graduating from secondary schools. Therefore, applications for the HKAGE “Online Screening programme” from these students will not be accepted.
4. All applications must be completed between **6 September 2021 (9:00 a.m.) to 29 October 2021 (12:00 noon)** via the “Online Application Platform”. No changes or withdrawals can be made after the application deadline.
5. To complete the application process, applicants should upload an **“application form with legal guardian’s signature”** and **“school attendance document”** (e.g. student card, student handbook, etc) before the application deadline.
6. It is the applicant’s responsibility to provide an **accurate and valid email address** for correspondence. If you do not receive the application confirmation email after submitting the application form, please contact School and Student Services Division by email (programme@hkage.org.hk) **within 3 working days**.
7. Students who have applied for the “Online Screening Programme” via “School Nomination” cannot apply for another “Online Screening Programme” via “Self Nomination”. The HKAGE will only consider the “School Nomination”.
