Certificate	<p>Participants who satisfy at least 75% attendance rate and fulfil the assessment requirements at respective levels will be awarded a certificate of Completion, Merit, or Distinction, issued by the HKAGE. Participants with outstanding performance will be nominated to apply to the HKSSMUNC 2020.</p>
Intended Learning Outcomes	<p>Upon completion of the programme, the participants should be able to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> write good quality position papers for various discussion topics under <u>three</u> UN committees' considerations. present their views and values systematically and critically through both moderated public speaking and debate setting for a designated country and committee allocation, with good teamwork; increase their awareness in global issues through effective research and readiness in well-balanced discussions; develop and apply effective people, communication and appreciation skills to negotiate and persuade, reach consensus and make responsible joint decisions with team members.
