Introduction

All HKAGE student members and other Hong Kong students are also welcomed to join us and submit childhood works to demonstrate your difference and uniqueness. You are invited to attend the Exhibition to share about your work.

Requirements of Work Collection

The work shall be made when you were at the age of 6 or below; only one item to be submitted.

- The work can be in various forms such as paintings, artwork, writing, poems, music, videos, science or engineering inventions, computer graphics, etc.
- The works submitted will be retained for exhibition, research, demonstration and other educational purposes, and will be returned at a later date, uncollected works will be disposed after a specific date.
- You are encouraged to submit a work which shows your originality and creativity!

Adjudication and Awards

Adjudication panel will be formed by gifted education practitioners for selecting the childhood works to be awarded and showcased at the Exhibition. Awardees will receive a book coupon and a certificate. Awards include but not limited to:

- Originality Award;
- Creativity Award;
- Inspiration Award;
- My Favourite Work (*voted by the visitors at the Exhibition*).
